

### **Past Events**

## New Years Day Dive.

January 1, 2006 is the Annual Sober Up Dive at Pleasure Bay Lagoon in South Boston. This annual event is usually a crowd pleaser. The Environmental Police are often on the scene. If you are unfamiliar with the Pleasure Bay Lagoon location, the easiest way to get there from the South or North is to take the Southeast Expressway and get off at the JFK/Columbia Circle exit. From the South, at the bottom of the exit ramp turn right. From the North, at the bottom of the exit ramp turn left. At the rotary take the second road, this will take you along the shore. Follow the road right to the lagoon.
